Pre-Kindergarten – 12th Grade Tuition Information 2017-2018

Tuition rates are for the 2017-2018 school year. Tuition includes all textbooks, workbooks, classroom supplies, and technology fees. Pre-Kindergarten tuition includes morning and afternoon snack. Tuition policies and rates are established in January for the next academic year. Parents have the financial obligation for full tuition, whether or not the student completes the school year.

When a student is accepted, the family receives an enrollment contract to be signed and returned to the school along with a non-refundable deposit. This \$800 deposit will be applied to the tuition.

The Tuition Plan

Tuition at Oak Mountain Academy can be paid in one of the following ways:

1. Full payment with 2% discount for current families due May 31.
2. Full payment with no discount due July 1.
3. Three payments (July 1, November 1 and February 1) plus a \$100 finance charge per payment; \$35 for Pre-K.
4. Ten payments (July 1 through April 1). Families on the ten-payment plan must pay by means of a monthly bank draft. This will include a \$50 finance charge per payment; \$20 for Pre-K.
A Truth-In-Lending Disclosure statement is enclosed in the Enrollment packet by grade for those electing the monthly payment plan.

Multiple Children Discount

For the family with more than one child enrolled at Oak Mountain Academy, tuition is reduced 5% for all students in a family beyond the eldest student who will pay full tuition.

Additional Expenses

Additional expenses may include after-school care, private piano, voice, guitar, bus transportation, uniforms, school portraits, yearbook, athletic wear, athletic fees, Advanced Placement testing, \$250 maintenance fee, special school trips and graduation fee. Lunches may be purchased through a third-party vendor.

After-School Care

Oak Mountain Academy offers after-school care for our students in Pre-K 4 through 8th grades. The after-school program continues until 6:00 pm. Charges are billed monthly at a rate of \$8.00 per hour with a one hour minimum.

Bus Service

Bus service is available from Douglasville and Villa Rica. Buses pick up and return students at central locations. Transportation charges are billed monthly.
