Oak Mountain Academy was founded in 1962 by the Reverend Mr. Richard Flinn, a Presbyterian minister, in the basement of a local church. Reverend Flinn envisioned a school that would offer its students a challenging curriculum while adhering to strong moral values in a family-style setting. In 1968 the Academy had its first class of graduating seniors and in 1997 the school moved to its current location. Today, more than 200 students in three-year-old pre-kindergarten through twelfth grades attend school on the beautiful 88-acre campus in Carrollton, Georgia.
