2023-2024 Lower School Student Supply Lists

PRE-K 3:

- 3 boxes of **JUMBO** Crayola crayons-8 pack (basic colors)
- 2 pks Glue Sticks
- 3 Canisters of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 Large Pack Napkins
- 1 Large box of **Flushable** wipes
- 2 Large packs of white paper plates (NO foam plates)
- 2 Large packs of Coffee Filters
- **Girls** only 1 box **Sandwich size** Ziploc bags
- **Boys** only 1 box **Gallon size** Ziplock bags
- 1 Large box of Kleenex tissue
- A pair of rain boots to be kept at school. Please write the child's name inside the boots.
- 3 white T-shirts, for example Fruit of the Loom. (**We will use one in November, December and the end of the school year. Please buy shirts big enough to fit your child at these times.**)
- A water bottle labeled with your child's name to be used at school daily. This will go home each night to be washed and refilled for the next day at school.
- A **FULL-SIZE** book bag (NO rolling bookbags or toddler book bags). **The bookbag needs to be able to fit a folder, lunch box, extra clothes, and a water bottle.**
- An extra change of clothes, to include: underwear, socks, T-shirt and shorts/pants placed in a **LABELED** Ziplock bag, to be kept at school. These do not have to be uniform clothes.
- Napping items for students staying all day: A child's size sleeping bag or roll up nap mat, and a small pillow if needed.

Please write your child's name (in permanent marker) on the following items:
Extra Clothes bag, Rain boots, Lunch box, Bookbag, Nap Mat and Water bottle

PRE-K 4:

- 1 box of Kleenex Tissue
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 3 containers of Clorox Disinfectant Wipes
- 1 can Lysol Disinfectant Spray
- 3 packs of baby wipes
- 1 pack of flushable wipes
- 1 large pack of napkins
- 1 pack of coffee filters
- 2 large packs of white paper plates (no foam please)
- 1 one inch three ring binder with plastic on the cover to insert a paper.
- 5 packs of Crayola crayons – 24 count (regular, not chubby)
- 1 pack of washable markers
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 big pink eraser
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 box Ticonderoga My First wood-cased pencils (12 count). These are the bigger ones, not regular size.
- A pair of rain boots to be kept at school. Please write the child's name inside the boots.
- 4 white t-shirts, for example a package of Fruit of the Loom. (These will be used throughout the year, so please be sure they are big enough. The average Pre-K child grows 2 inches in one school year. These shirts will shrink.
- A water bottle labeled with your child's name to be used at school daily. This will go home each night to be washed and refilled for the next day at school.
- A full-size book bag; to be brought to school each day. No rolling book bags or toddler book bags please. The book bag needs to be able to fit a folder, lunch box, extra clothes bag, and water bottle.
- An extra change of clothes to include: underwear, socks, t-shirt and shorts placed in a LABELED Ziploc bag, to be kept in their book bag. These do not have to be uniform clothes.
- Napping items for students staying for rest time: A child's size sleeping bag or a roll up nap mat.

Please do not label any supplies, except pencil box, extra clothes bag, and rain boots. Be sure that your child's book bag, lunch box, and water bottle are labeled each day.

Kindergarten:

Unlabeled items:

- 1 box of Ticonderoga #2 pencils: "My First" size
- 8 boxes of Crayola crayons – 8 count box (Large, but NOT Jumbo sized)
- 1 box of Kleenex tissue
- 3 boxes of straws (only if your child orders milk from OMA)

Girls Only:

- 1 Large pack of white napkins
- 3 pack of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 box of plastic forks

Boys Only:

- 1 Large pack of white paper plates
- 2 packs of Paper Towels
- 1 box of plastic spoons

Labeled Items:

- A **full-sized book bag** that is large enough to hold 2 folders, a notebook, and a lunchbox. It should have a water bottle pocket on the outside. (No Rolling Book Bags, please.)
- A **water bottle** that will not spill when tipped over. (**water only**) This is needed daily. Please fill it daily with water before school.
- Extra **clothes** to be used in case of spills, wet slides, or any type of accident. (underwear, socks, t-shirt, & bottoms/not uniform) Keep in a bookbag and change with the season.
- Child's **rest mat** (should fit in 12 x 12 cubby)
- Fun, cute **candle** to be used at story time (by the teacher)

Post-it label only (name written on post-it note):

- ½ inch white binder for Dolch notebook
- Recent photo (to be returned)

1st Grade:

- 1 plastic rectangular pencil with attached lid
- 3 packs of #2 pencils (regular size, not fat pencils)
- 1 pack of pink large erasers
- 1 pair of scissors
- 3 packs of CRAYOLA crayons
- 8-10 glue sticks
- 1 pack of CRAYOLA markers (10 count)
- 2 plastic folders with pockets
- 1 box of plastic spoons
- 1 box of plastic forks
- facial tissues (Kleenex)

2nd Grade:

- Crayons (2 packs 24 count)
- #2 pencils (2 packs regular size)
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- 1 Plastic pencil box with attached lid (no pouches)
- 2 composition books (no spiral)
- Wide ruled notebook paper (1 pack)
- 2 plastic folder with pockets
- 1 pack pink large erasers
- 1 pack paper plates
- Kleenex - 1 box
- Clorox wipes
- 1 box plastic forks (no spoons needed)

3rd Grade:

- Notebook/Binder - 1 ½ inch - Choose one that you will enjoy using every day. We will place all instructional materials in the notebook.
- Notebook Dividers - The notebook will be divided into the following sections: Morning Work, Reading/Spelling, Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Please organize your notebook before the first day of school. The zipper type binders are too large for our third-grade desks and cubbies.
- Notebook Paper - Wide rule only. (3 - 100 sheet packs)
- Pencils - Ticonderoga - Two 24 count packs. Students may bring a closed type personal pencil sharpener to keep at their desks. We do not use mechanical pencils or pens during the first semester.
- Glue - 1 pack of glue sticks (3 count) and one regular size bottle of white Elmer's school glue.
- Crayons - Crayola - Personal choice as to size of box.
- Crayola Markers-12 count
- 2 large book covers - The stretchy ones work very well.
- Pencil/Supply Box - If you would like a container to keep your supplies organized in your cubby. A good size is somewhere around 6 inches by 10 ½ inches.
- Backpack/Book Bag – Rolling book bag recommended.

4th Grade:

All supplies listed below are required for all students for each teacher. Please bag each teachers' supplies separately and make sure they are labeled with your child's name and the teacher's name.
