Lower School Student Supply List by Grade **2020-21 Academic Year**

Pre-K3 - Mrs. Lynn's Class

- 4 boxes of **JUMBO** Crayola crayons-8 pack (basic colors)
- 1 pair Earbuds
- 1 box of Large Crayola markers-8 pack (basic colors)
- 3 Canisters of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 Large Pack Napkins
- 2 Large Rolls Paper Towels
- 1 Large box of **Flushable** wipes
- 1 Large pack of white paper plates (**NO** foam plates)
- **Girls** only 3 Large packs of plastic **spoons**
- **Boys** only 3 Large packs of plastic **forks**
- 1 Large box of Straws
- 2 Large packs of Coffee Filters
- **Girls** only 1 box **Sandwich size** Ziplock bags
- **Boys** only 1 box **Gallon size** Ziplock bags
- 1 Large box of Kleenex tissue
- A pair of rain boots to be kept at school. Please write the child's name inside the boots.
- 3 white T-shirts, for example Fruit of the Loom. (We will use one in November, December and the end of the school year. Please buy the shirts big enough to fit your child at these times.)
- A water bottle labeled with your child's name to be used at school daily. This will go home each night to be washed and refilled for the next day at school.
- A FULL-SIZE book bag (NO rolling bookbags or toddler bookbags). The bookbag needs to be able to fit a folder, lunch box, extra clothes bag and a water bottle.
- An extra change of clothes, to include: underwear, socks, T-shirt and shorts placed in a **LABELED** Ziplock bag, to be kept at school. These do not have to be uniform clothes.
- Napping items for students staying all day: A child's size sleeping bag or roll up nap mat, and a small pillow if needed.

Please write your child's name (in permanent marker) on the following items:

Extra Clothes bag, Rain boots, Lunch box, Bookbag, and Water bottle

Pre-K4 Supply List – Mrs. Kaitlin / Mrs. Marni

- 1 box of Kleenex Tissue
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 3 containers of Clorox Disinfectant Wipes
- 1 container of baby wipes (Boys Only)
- 2 packs of flushable wipes (Girls Only)
- 1 large packs of napkins
- 3 boxes of plastic spoons (Girls Only)
- 3 boxes of forks (Boys Only)
- 2 boxes of 100 straws (Only if your child is ordering milk from OMA)
- 1 large pack of white paper plates (no foam please)
- 4 packs of Crayola crayons – 24 count (regular, not chubby)
- A pair of rain boots to be kept at school. Please write the child's name inside the boots.
- 4 white t-shirts, for example a package of Fruit of the Loom. (These will be used throughout the year, so please be sure they are big enough. The average Pre-K child grows 2 inches in one school year. These shirts will shrink.
- A water bottle labeled with your child's name to be used at school daily. This will go home each night to be washed and refilled for the next day at school.
- A full-size book bag; to be brought to school each day. No rolling book bags or toddler book bags please. The book bag needs to be able to fit a folder, lunch box, extra clothes bag, and water bottle.
- An extra change of clothes to include: underwear, socks, t-shirt and shorts placed in a LABELED Ziploc bag, to be kept in their book bag. These do not have to be uniform clothes.
- Napping items for students staying for rest time: A child's size sleeping bag or a roll up nap mat.

Please do not label any supplies, except extra clothes bag and rain boots. Be sure that your child's book bag, lunch box, and water bottle are labeled each day.

Kindergarten Supply List – Mrs. Elise

Put a post-it note with child's name (I will label them.):

- 1 red plastic 2 pocket folder with prongs
- 1 blue plastic 2 pocket folder with prongs
- 1/2 inch white binder for Dolch Notebook

Unlabeled Items:

- 3 boxes: 8 pack Crayola crayons (large size / classic colors)
- 3 boxes: 8 pack Crayola crayons (regular size / classic colors)
- 3 boxes: 24 pack Crayola crayons (regular size / classic colors)
- 3 pack of Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 pack of inexpensive paper plates
- 1 pack of napkins
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of inexpensive forks
- 1 box of inexpensive spoons
- Napping items for rest time: A child's size sleeping bag or a roll up nap mat.

Labeled Items:

- A full-sized book bag that is large enough to hold folders, notebooks, & a lunchbox. It should have a water bottle holder on the outside (no rolling book bags).
- A water bottle that will not spill when tipped over. (water only please)
- Extra clothes to be used in case of spills, wet slides, or any accident. (underwear, socks, t-shirt, & shorts) It does not need to be a uniform.
- Fun, cute candle to be used at story time when it is your child's turn
- A current photo (close-up view/ it will be returned)
- Nap Mat
