

# OAK MOUNTAIN ACADEMY COMMUNITY PARTNERS – Descriptors

**Annual Fund Donor**: Currently, tuition covers approximately 85% of the total cost of educating our students. The remaining 15% comprises fund development sources, such as the Annual Fund, Sponsorships, Special Events, and Community Partners. Annual Fund donors are recognized via social media and within the annual report.

Platinum Level: Scholars Society (\$8,000+) Gold Level: Legacy Society (\$6,000 - \$7,999 Silver Level: Trustee Society (\$4,000 - \$5,999)
